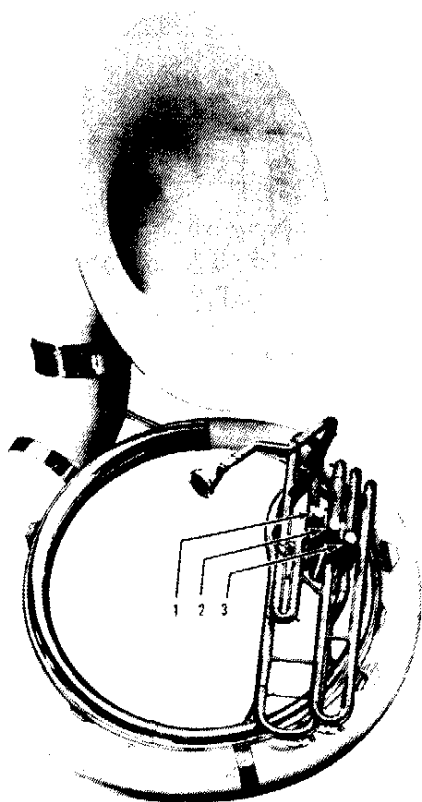


FINGERING CHART

For BB \flat and E \flat Bass



How To Read The Chart

● – Valve down

○ – Valve up

When two notes are given together on a chart (F \sharp and G \flat), they are the same tone and, of course, played with the same fingering.
